Dr. Randy Bagg, Global Regulatory Innovation Adviser at Elanco Animal Health Canada was recently presented with the Canadian Animal Health Institute's (CAHI) internal "Recognizing Its Leaders Award" for his significant contributions to the Canadian animal health industry.

"The knowledge and insight Randy has provided as Chair of our Drug Committee have helped to position CAHI well in discussions with our stakeholders and regulators, particularly in the area of antimicrobial use and resistance", said CAHI President Jean Szkotnicki in presenting Dr. Bagg with the award. "We volunteered as an industry to remove the growth promotion claims from medically important antimicrobials under his leadership which was a critical step forward in demonstrating our combined interests in responsible use."

Upon receiving the award, Dr. Bagg expressed his thanks to the industry for recognizing his contributions. "I am honoured and humbled to receive this award", said Dr. Bagg. "I truly believe that together we can make a difference."

Dr. Bagg graduated from the Ontario Veterinary College, University of Guelph in 1979 and practiced large animal (bovine) veterinary medicine for 15 years before joining Elanco Animal Health Canada in 1994. Randy is the chair of the CAHI Drug Committee and is the CAHI-nominated member for the CVMA National Issues Committee, and the Canadian Animal Health Products Regulatory Advisory Committee. He is also a Director at the Animal Nutrition Association of Canada and sits on the Livestock Medicines Advisory Committee in Ontario.

The CAHI is the trade association representing the manufacturers and distributors of animal medications in Canada. This internal award was created to recognize the significant contributions made by its individual members through exemplary contributions to the CAHI and its objectives.
